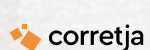
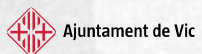

The **Union Cycliste Internationale** (UCI) is the world governing body for cycling recognised by the **International Olympic Committee** (IOC).

The UCI's mission is to develop and promote cycling -in close collaboration with the National Federations- as **competitive sport**, as a **healthy recreational activity** and as a **mean of transport**.

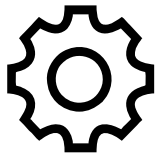
TRIALS IS ONE OF THE MOST EXCITING UCI DISCIPLINES

The main factors are the **stability and the control of the bike in extreme situations**. Riders must demonstrate their bike handling skills on an obstacles course.

It brings together almost all the cycling skills: Physical fitness, concentration, agility, balance, strength and coordination. **All in all, total control of the bike is acquired.**

All cycling disciplines involve bike-handling skills, these skills constitute the essence of Trials. **Trials certainly offers extremely useful crossover benefits.**

Any obstacle can be rideable. In competition the most popular are rocks, precast shapes, logs or wooden structures. Riders use amazing movements to cross them such as: **side hop, pedal up, hook up, gap to front, back wheel jump...** the movements are not judged, they only allow riders to achieve their points.



HOW IT WORKS

FOLLOW THE ARROWS, STAY WITHIN THE LINE AND KEEP YOUR FEET ON THE PEDALS!

THE CONCEPT IS SIMPLE: **CROSS THE GATES "CLEAN" WITHOUT SETTING ANY FEET OR PART OF THE BIKE ON THE GROUND, EXCEPT THE RUBBER OF THE TIRES**

COLLECT 10 POINTS AT EVERY GATE CROSSED "CLEAN". 60 POINTS IS THE BEST POSSIBLE SCORE PER SECTION, 300 PER LAP IS SUPERB!

THE RIDER WITH THE HIGHEST SCORE IS THE WINNER!

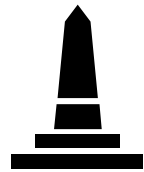
Vic is the **capital of the county of Osona**. With a population of **48.000 people** and a surface of 30.92 km². The city is at 485 m above sea level.
